Maryland Utilities Issue Request For Proposals For The Supply Of Wholesale Electric Power

BALTIMORE – Sept. 9, 2022 – Potomac Edison, Baltimore Gas and Electric Company (BGE), Delmarva Power, and Potomac Electric Power Company (Pepco) have issued Requests for Proposals (RFPs) for full-requirements, wholesale electric power supply to meet their Standard Offer Service (SOS) obligations in their Maryland service territories.

Each utility will provide market-based supply service to some or all of its electric customers who do not take service from competitive retail suppliers. The RFPs will consist of supply contracts ranging in term from three to twenty-four months.

For BGE and Delmarva Power the bidding for residential and small commercial Type 1 contracts will occur in two procurements in October 2022 and April 2023. Contract terms will be twenty-four months and will be for supply services beginning June 1, 2023, and October 1, 2023, respectively.

For Pepco, the bidding for the combined residential and small commercial Type 1 contracts will occur in three procurements in October 2022, April 2023 and at another date to be determined in 2023. Contract terms will be eight, twelve, and sixteen months in length and will be for supply services beginning June 1, 2023, October 1, 2023, and October 1, 2024.

For Potomac Edison, the bidding for residential contracts will occur in four procurements in October 2022 and in January, April, and June of 2023. The contract terms will range in length from four to sixteen months for supply services beginning June 1, 2023, and June 1, 2024.

For all the Maryland utilities, the bidding for larger commercial Type II contracts will be for three-month contracts and will occur quarterly. The quarterly procurements will occur in October 2022 and in January, April and June of 2023. Further details regarding the

procurement schedule, including the bid due dates for this multi-procurement process can be found in the RFP documents. The four utilities will conduct their bidding processes concurrently under uniform rules and timetables.

The utilities are requesting proposals totaling approximately 3,805 megawatts (MW), including:

- 677 MW for **Potomac Edison**
- 1,879 MW for **BGE**
- 314 MW for **Delmarva Power**
- 935 MW for **Pepco**

A joint-utility pre-bid webinar will be held on Sept. 20, 2022, at 1 p.m. EDT. The webinar will review the general RFP structure and process, the specific utility bid plans and the power supply contract.
